

**VILLAGE OF STROME
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

BYLAW NO. 762-10

BEING A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF STROME, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO PROVIDE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF A SYSTEM FOR THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND TO PROVIDE FOR GARBAGE PICK-UP RATES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF STROME.

WHEREAS under authority of Section 7 and 8 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26, a Council of a municipality may pass bylaws regulating the provision of its public utility services;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to revise the rates for the provision of waste disposal within the Village of Strome;


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Strome duly assembled enacts as follows:


- 1) That it be known that a service charge for all **residential**, door to door truck garbage pick-up, as well as associated costs for the local sanitation site facility be levied at **\$20.00** (twenty dollars) **per month** for each water and sewer utility subscriber who is served directly with garbage pick-up in the Village of Strome;
- 2) That all non-residential utility accounts who are not renting their own bin from the Flagstaff Regional Solid Waste Management Association shall be levied a service charge as follows:
 - a. Flagstaff County \$20.00 per month
 - b. Flagstaff Regional Housing \$20.00 per month, per occupying resident
 - c. Commercial (average usage) \$20.00 per month
 - d. Commercial (low usage) \$10.00 per month
 - e. Community Related Centres \$10.00 per month
*(such as the Senior's Centre,
Churches, Museum Buildings, etc.)*
- 3) That it has been agreed to share all related costs for the garbage bin located at the Strome Community Hall as follows:
 - a. Strome & District Agricultural Society 60%
 - b. Village of Strome 40%
- 4) That the above charges will continue on all Utility Accounts regardless of whether the water and sewer charges have been stopped due to the water being turned off by owner's request or due to non-payment of arrears.
- 5) That these service charges shall be billed monthly and shown on the water and sewer utility billing separately;
- 6) That the rates of penalty and dates of payment as established in ByLaw #761-10 shall apply;
- 7) That incineration of waste materials within the Village of Strome is prohibited by this ByLaw;
- 8) That this ByLaw repeals and replaces any other ByLaw or motion previously made with respect to garbage service charges.

READ a first time this 6th day of May, 2010.

READ a second time this 6th day of May, 2010.

READ a third time and finally passed this 6th day of May, 2010.
